## 7.1: GENERAL POINTS PREVAILING THE TARIFF: △

- All amounts are in Indian Rupees and Taxes are additional to be levied on all charges as per Government Regulations.
- OOG (Out-of-Gauge) consignments will be quoted on a case-by-case basis, considering Gross Out-to-Out Dimensions (Length x Width x Height), Gross Weight (inclusive of Tare), and required handling protocols. Final pricing shall be determined upon receipt of complete engineering diagrams, dimensional data, weight specifications, and photographs."
- Carting of Export cargo brought in container(s), will be subject to SSR Charges.
- Charges for Lift-On of Empty containers from other CFS/Empty Park for stuffing at VISVASA CFS must be paid by CHA/Shipper and upon submission of the corresponding payment receipt, CFS shall arrange to pick up the empty containers.
- Cargo brought into the CFS in Jute, PP, or HDPE bags for subsequent bulking shall be handled at the sole risk of the Customs Broker/Shipper. The CFS shall not be liable for any loss or damage to the bags or cargo during this process. Furthermore, the CFS reserves the right to dispose of any residual bags or cargo left unclaimed beyond seven (07) days from either the date of export stuffing or gate-in—whichever is earlier—without prior notice to the Customs Broker/Shipper.
- An empty import container cleared under a Bill of Entry for domestic use will incur charges as per the Import Laden Tariff.
- Hazardous cargo declaration by the Shipping Lines / Shipper is mandatorily for the safe handling. VISVASA CFS reserves the right to reject any hazardous cargo in the premises.
- Tariff for any other services will be quoted on case-to-case basis.
- Composite Charges includes 01-07 days of Cargo storage charges in the Export. 01-03 days of Container ground rent in the Export Cycle and 01-03 days in the Import Cycle.
- Cargo Storage charges are reckoned from the date of carting or de-stuffing to the date of stuffing or loading, both days inclusive and for laden it will be reckoned from the date of gate in of container.
- Packing Material of Import De-stuff Cargo should be collected by Importer / CHA along with delivery of Cargo itself. If retrieved separately at later stage, applicable charges will apply. Unclaimed packing material will be disposed of after 24 hours from Cargo Delivery without further notice.
- Cargo requiring special services, dunnage, lashing, additional equipment will be charged separately and subject to SSR.
- Customs overtime charges, if applicable for work conducted at the CFS, shall be borne by the Shipping Line or CHA.
- All cheques/DDs should be drawn in favour of 'Liladhar Pasoo Forwarders Private Limited,' payable at Gandhidham. A PD Account system is available for clients to facilitate easy transactions.
- It is presumed that all import/export consignments received at the CFS are adequately insured against risks during transportation and storage. VISVASA CFS assumes no liability in this regard.
- Levies / Penalties imposed to by Government, Judicial, Quasi-Judicial authorities will be recovered from concern Party.
- All dues of the CFS must be cleared prior to the movement of export containers or delivery of import cargo.
- GST and other Government levies shall be applicable at the prevailing rates at the time of billing.
- Export container movement requests must be submitted at least 24 hours prior to the port gate cut-off.
- For export-loaded containers, movement requests submitted within 24 hours of the vessel's port gate cut-off will subject to SSR charges, to be borne by the CHA/Shipper/Client.
- Costs for transportation to a government-approved waste handling facility shall be borne by the customer (Shipper/ Importer). Detailed hazardous cargo declarations must be provided to ensure safe handling, stacking, and segregation.
- Subject to applicable norms and compliance standards, CFS reserves the right to allow or reject specific hazardous commodities within its premises.
- Unless otherwise specified, containers exceeding 40' in size will be charged at 1.5 times the FEU rate.
- Weighing of import/ Export laden containers are mandatory, as per the directive issued by the Assistant Commissioner (DP), CH: MP&SEZ, Mundra, under letter reference F. No. S/DP-08/MPSEZ/2009, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2009 and F. No. VIII/48-01/DP-MPSEZ/2011-12, dated 31<sup>st</sup> October 2011.
- To deter malpractice, any dishonoured cheque will attract an exemplary penalty of INR 5,000.
- Cheque payments require prior approval from finance department on working days between 10:00–18:00 hrs.
- Outstation cheques will be accepted subject to bank charge recovery, and container/cargo movement will proceed only upon cheque clearance.
- VISVASA CFS reserves the right to modify rates at its discretion without any obligation of prior notice to the customer.
- All additional terms and conditions shall be governed by the prevailing policies and discretion of VISVASA CFS.
